

International visitors accounted for 300,993 trips and 4,129,779 total nights to British Columbia in 2020. During this time period, visitors from China took the most trips, 39,981 or 13.3% of total trips. Visitors from China accounted for 593,919 total nights which accounts for 14.4% of total nights spent by international visitors to this province. Compared to 2019, total trips were down significantly year over year and month over month with the exception of January.

The majority of visitors from the United Kingdom travelled to these provinces during the summer months. Ontario and British Columbia account for the most nights spent, during the month of July, UK visitors spent nearly 800,000 and 575,000 nights in Ontario and British Columbia respectively.
